## **Membership Eligibility**

Philanthropy Missouri's Full Members meet all of the following requirements:

Are a community foundation, corporate foundation or corporate charitable contribution program, donor-advised fund, family foundation, federated fund, giving circle, health conversion foundation, intermediary, private foundation, public religious charity, or publicly- or tax-supported grantmaking organization.
Have as their primary charitable activity the making of grants for charitable, educational, religious, and/or scientific purposes;
Make grants to multiple, unrelated organizations (vs. to one institution); <b>and</b>
Devote a majority of their charitable budget to their grantmaking programs and activities (rather than fundraising).

Final approval of applicant Members is made by the Philanthropy Missouri Engagement Committee of the Board and is based on the applicant's fit with the eligibility criteria stated above. Philanthropy Missouri does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, age, disability, or any other legally protected characteristics.
